

# Idiomatic Expressions

- 1) Don't go bananas. become very angry, upset or excited.
- 2) Be snowed under. be overwhelmed with a very large quantity of something, especially work
- 3) A bitter pill. an unpleasant or painful necessity (to accept).
- 4) Bed of roses. used in reference to a situation or activity that is comfortable or easy.
- 5) Beat around the bush. To treat a topic, but omit its main points, often intentionally. (idiomatic) To delay or avoid talking about something difficult or unpleasant.
- 6) All ears: means that one is listening with one's full attention

- Stella, I am not extremely happy.

- Nothing. Do not worry about it.
  
- Please do not beat around the bush. Tell me what's going on. I'm all ears.
